Having been brought up on Anglesey, we know and love this beautiful island inside out. Whether you're after a dose of adventure, a moment of calm, or a little local flavour, there's something special here for everyone. Here are a few of our personal favourite things to do close to your accommodation:

RIB RIDE & E-FOIL ADVENTURES

Feel the wind in your hair as you speed across the Menai Strait on a rib ride — it's exhilarating and offers stunning views of the coastline, Puffin Island, and sometimes even seals and porpoises. For something truly unique, why not try E-foiling? It's a thrilling experience that lets you glide above the water on an electric hydrofoil board.

WATERSPORTS FOR THE ADVENTEROUS

Whether you're a seasoned pro or trying something new, the beaches near Newborough offer fantastic conditions for a range of watersports — from windsurfing and kitesurfing to wing foiling, stand-up paddleboarding, and surfing. Feel free to bring your own kit or book lessons and rentals locally.

Pro tip: Always check the wind forecast before heading out, especially for off-shore winds, and make sure to wear appropriate safety gear like lifejackets for a safe and fun experience. For lessons, equipment hire, and more info, we recommend <u>Funsport</u>.

WILD SWIMMING + SAUNA BLISS

There's nothing quite like a refreshing swim in the sea or one of the island's hidden coves. Early morning is especially magical — just you, the water, and the soft sound of waves. For the ultimate experience, we highly recommend following your dip with a visit to a wood-fired beach sauna.

Our favourite spot is Porth Tyn Tywyn, where <u>Sauna Wales</u> offers a truly unique sauna-with-a-view. It's a beautiful way to warm up, unwind, and take in the scenery — and it's become a bit of a ritual for us.





FUN FOR THE KIDS

A perfect day out for families includes a visit to <u>Foel Farm Park</u>, where children can meet and feed friendly animals while adults relax in the cosy on-site café with locally sourced snacks. Nearby, the <u>Anglesey Sea Zoo</u> offers a fascinating glimpse into local marine life — it's small, friendly, and great even on rainy days. For something quirky and unique, don't miss <u>Tacla Taid</u> in Newborough, a charming small transport museum that delights kids and adults alike, complete with a lovely café to unwind afterwards.

HALEN MÔN - ANGLESEY SEA SALT

Take a guided tour and discover how this award-winning <u>sea salt</u> is made right here on the island. The gift shop is a treat too — perfect for picking up nice gifts.

WALK TO LLANDDWYN ISLAND

The walk through Newborough Forest and out to the tidal island of Llanddwyn is simply unforgettable. Wild ponies, golden sands, endless skies, and the most romantic lighthouse view you'll ever see. Important: Llanddwyn is a tidal island and can become cut off at high water during spring tides. Be sure to check tide times before setting out so you can explore safely and return without getting stranded.

TAKE IN THE NATURE AROUND YOU

Our cottages are set in an area that is teeming with wildlife and natural beauty, from red squirrels in the forest to rare coastal wildflowers and seabirds circling overhead. We encourage guests of all ages to keep a little nature log during their stay — jot down the birds, plants, shells, or creatures you spot on your walks or while relaxing outdoors. It's a peaceful, fun way to slow down and really take in the landscape. You never know what you'll discover.
