



EXPLORING

Having spent years exploring this part of Anglesey, these are the places we return to time and time again.

Whether it's a slow walk along the shore, a wander through the dunes, or simply finding a quiet spot in the forest — there's plenty to discover close to the cabins.

NEWBOROUGH FOREST & LLANDDWYN

A gentle walk through Newborough Forest leads you to Traeth Llanddwyn — one of the most beautiful beaches in the UK.

Continue across to Ynys Llanddwyn, where you'll find the lighthouse, old cottages and views across to Snowdonia. It's just as magical early in the morning as it is at sunset.

Llanddwyn Island is tidal, so remember to check the time of high water before you set off.

ABER MENAI DUNES

For something quieter, head south-east from the cabins towards the Menai Strait and along the undulating dunes towards Aber Menai.

This route feels more wild and untouched — with birdlife, coastal plants, roaming ponies and wide views across to the mountains.

Loop back along the southern edge of the beach for a peaceful, nature-filled walk away from the main paths.
